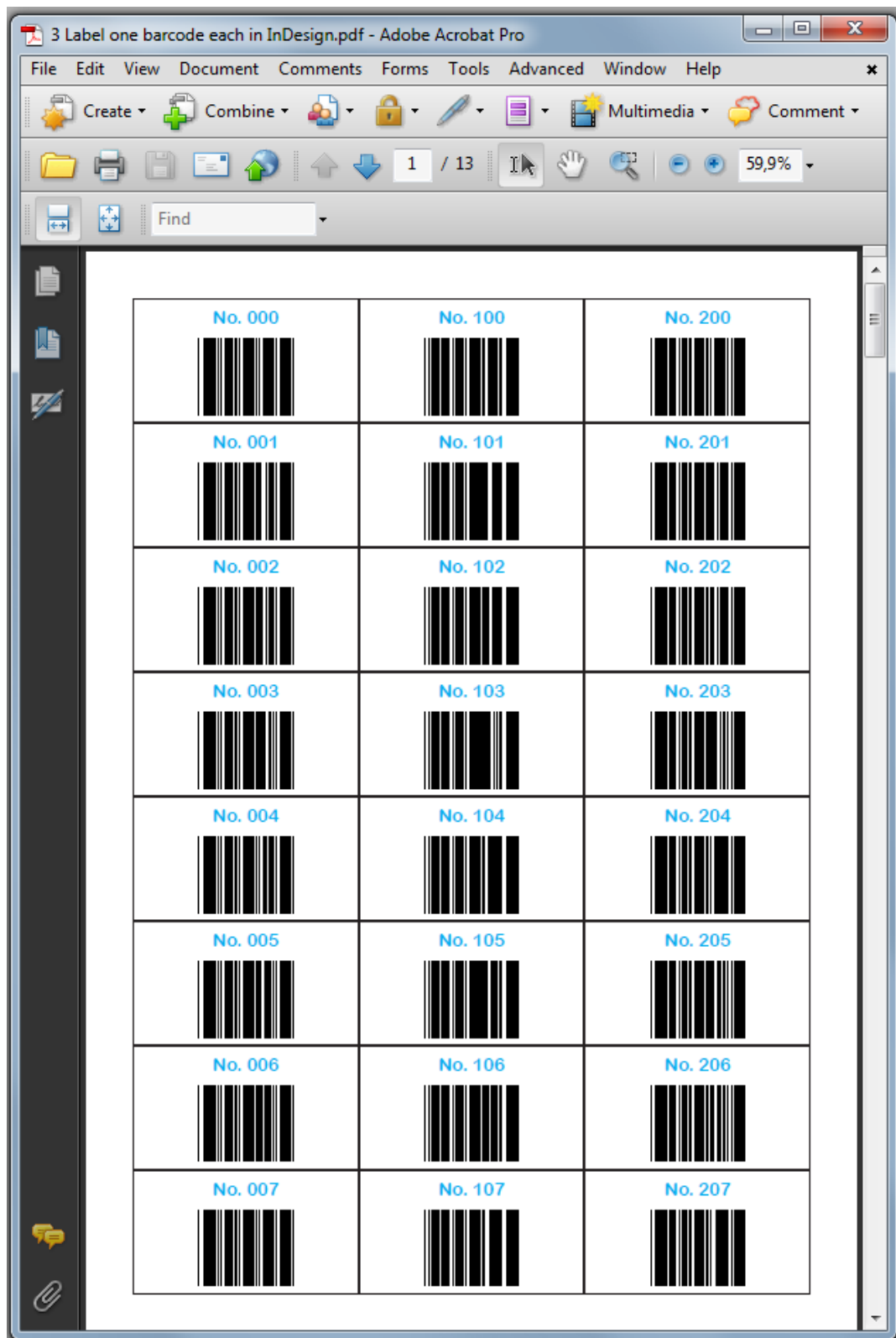


Data merge 3 columns with barcodes in Adobe InDesign.

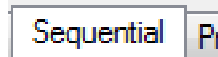
Only works in Barcode Image Maker Pro v3.40 or better.

You can also use Code Barcode Maker Pro v3.40 or better, Retail Barcode Maker Pro v3.40 (please note Code 39 is not supported), Barcode Maker v7.40 or better.

I am going to show how to have three columns and 3 labels and then data merge barcode images and also data merge text above the barcode. Let's get started. Barcode software used is Barcode Image Maker Pro.

Make Sequence

Click on the Sequential TAB in Barcode Image Maker Pro ([Download here](#))

Make Sequential

Code 39 has been selected as the barcode to use in Select Barcode. As we only have two digits in the Sequence [NUM1] and wants three. Fill in 0[NUM1] (Right click is also possible) in [NUM1][NUM2] or [ADV] Sequence, this will make 000 to 099. Check 'Clear Barcode List before adding sequential'. To add the sequence to the barcode list, click on the Make Sequential button. Please look at the above image.

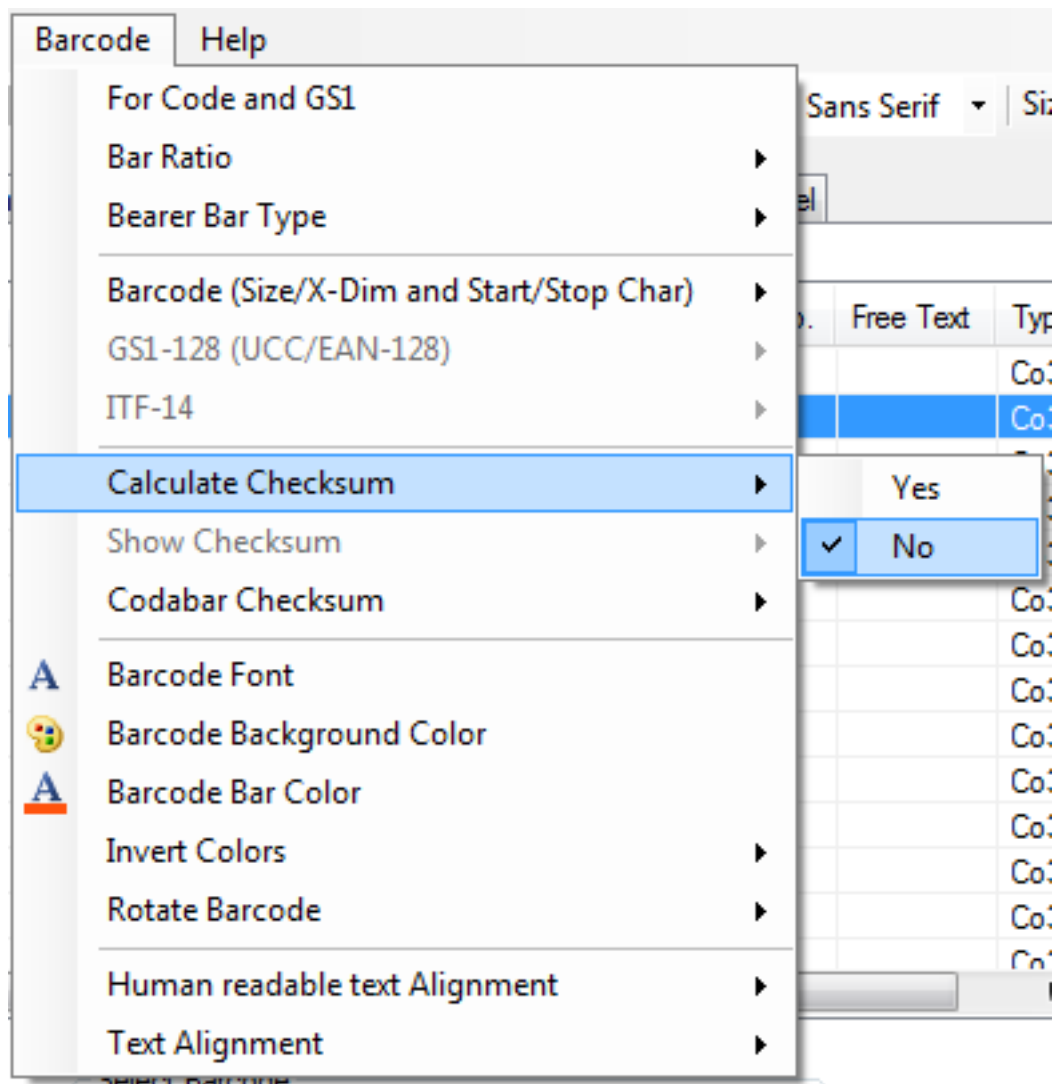

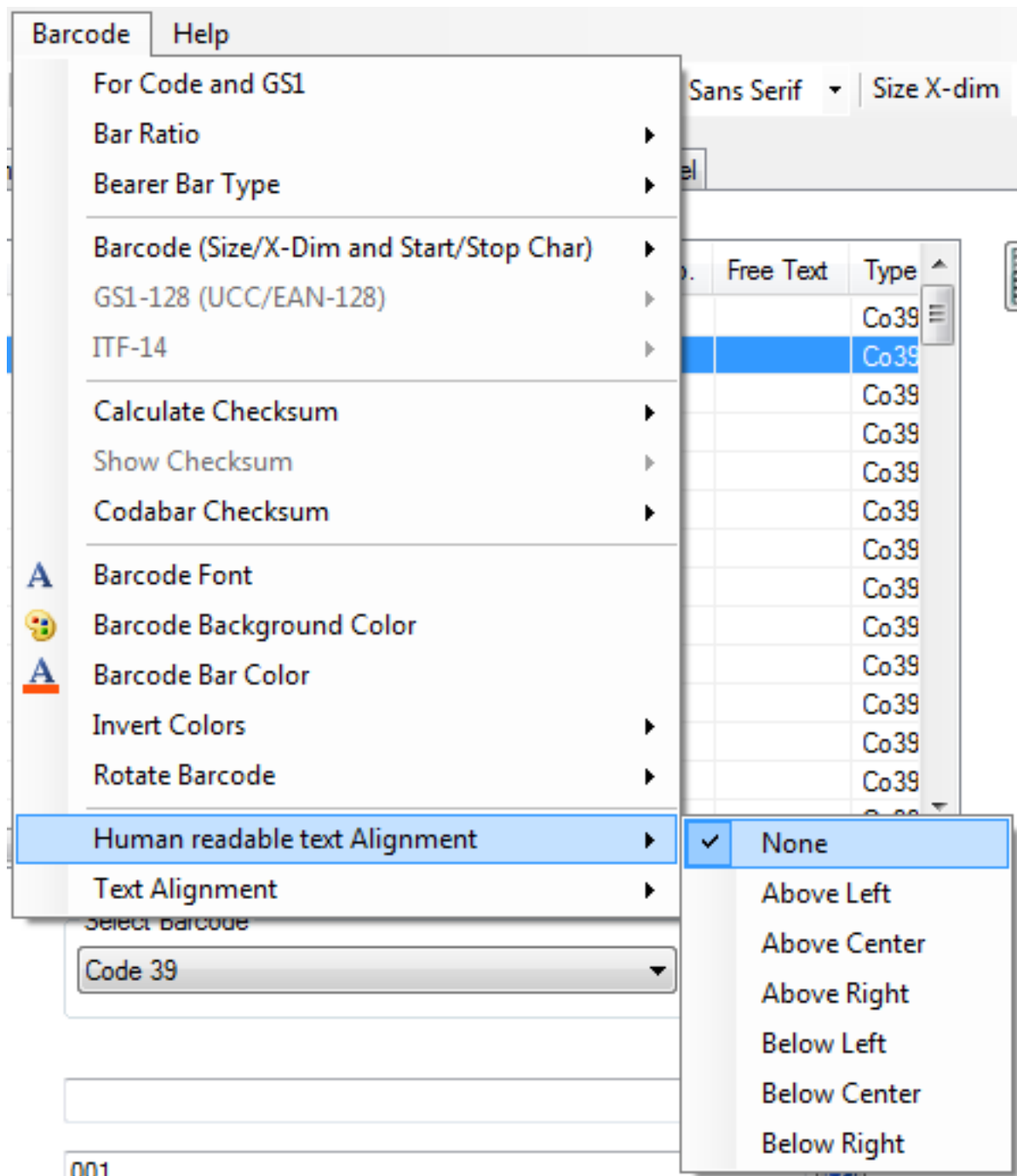

I have clicked on the first entry in the Barcode List, the barcode image is shown to the right. As you can see there are 4 digits, we wanted 3, the last digit is the checksum. Please look at the above image.



To remove the checksum, click on the Barcode menu and then go to Calculate Checksum, click on No. The checksum will not be calculated and shown in the barcode image. Please look at the above image.



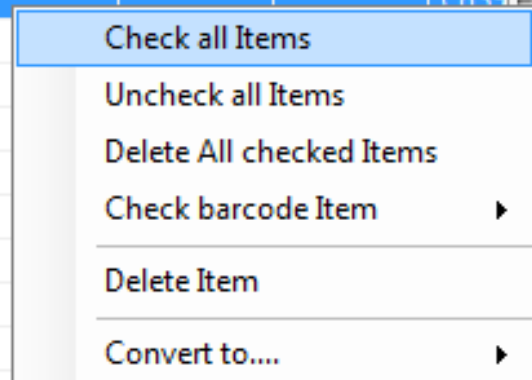
As we are going to add some text above the barcode, we do not need the human readable text below the barcode, so let's remove it. Click on the Barcode menu and then go to Human readable text alignment, please click on None. The digits below the barcode will be removed. Please look at the above image.

3 Labels one barcode each in InDesign

We need to make a folder. I will make the one shown above. To make things a bit easier I will add a Sub Folder. Please look at the above image.

Label1

Open the folder you have already made (3 Labels one barcode each in InDesign) and then make a Sub Folder, named Label1. Make sure you have opened the sub folder, Label1.

Fill in anything as the File Name. Select the file format you would like to save the barcodes as, I will be using Encapsulated PostScript *.eps. Click on the Save button to save all barcode images in the Label1 sub folder. When you have saved the barcode images, then let's make the next sequence. Please look at the above image.

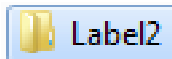

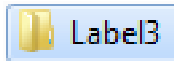

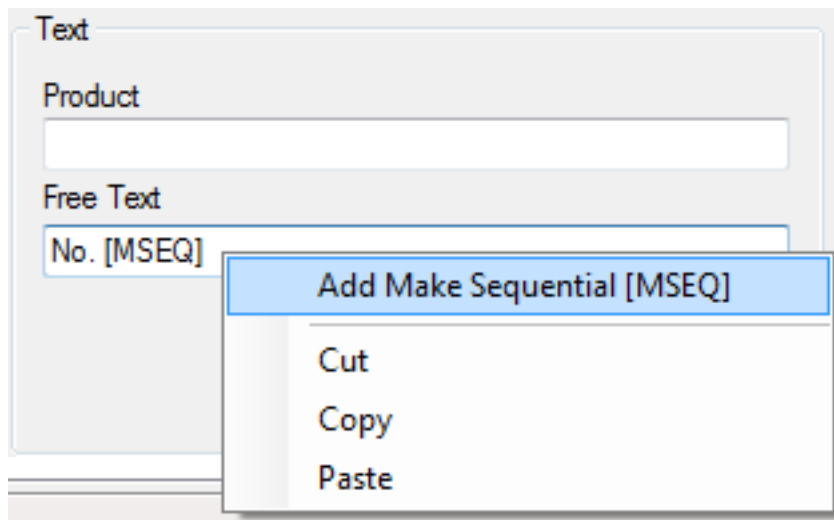


Click on the Save as icon in the Toolbar.



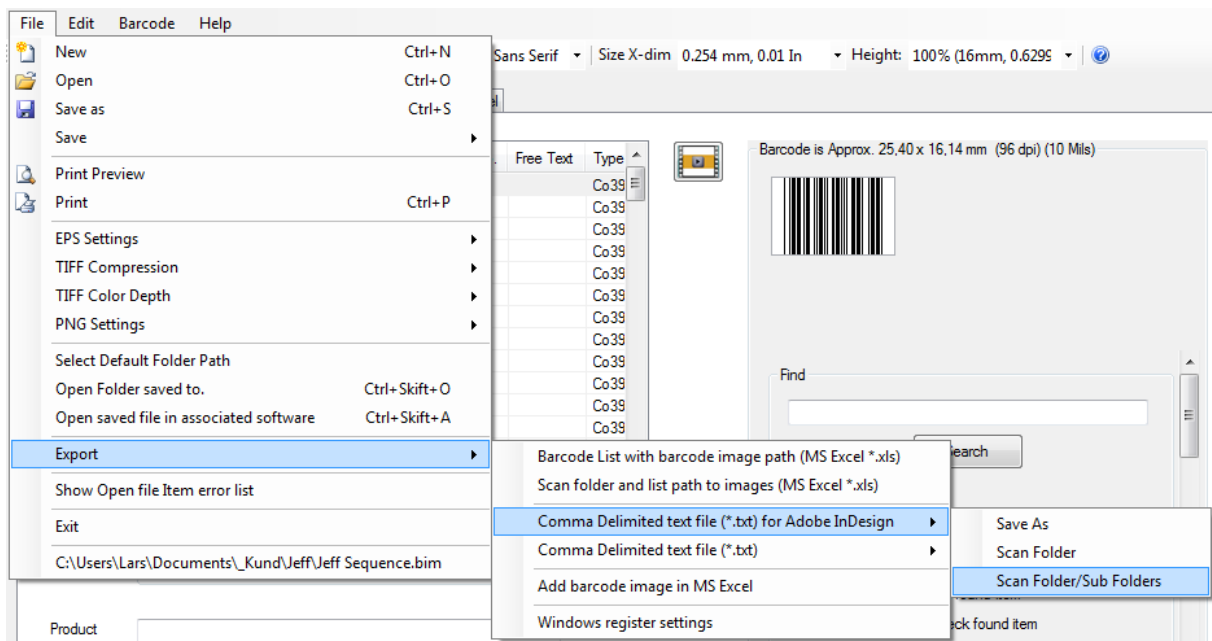
Open the folder you have already made (3 Labels one barcode each in InDesign) and then make a Sub Folder, named Label3. Make sure you have opened the sub folder, Label3. Please look at the above image.

Fill in anything as the File Name. Select the file format you would like to save the barcodes as, I will be using Encapsulated PostScript *.eps. Click on the Save button to save all barcode images in the Label3 sub folder. When you have saved the barcode images, and then let's make the next sequence. Please look at the above image.

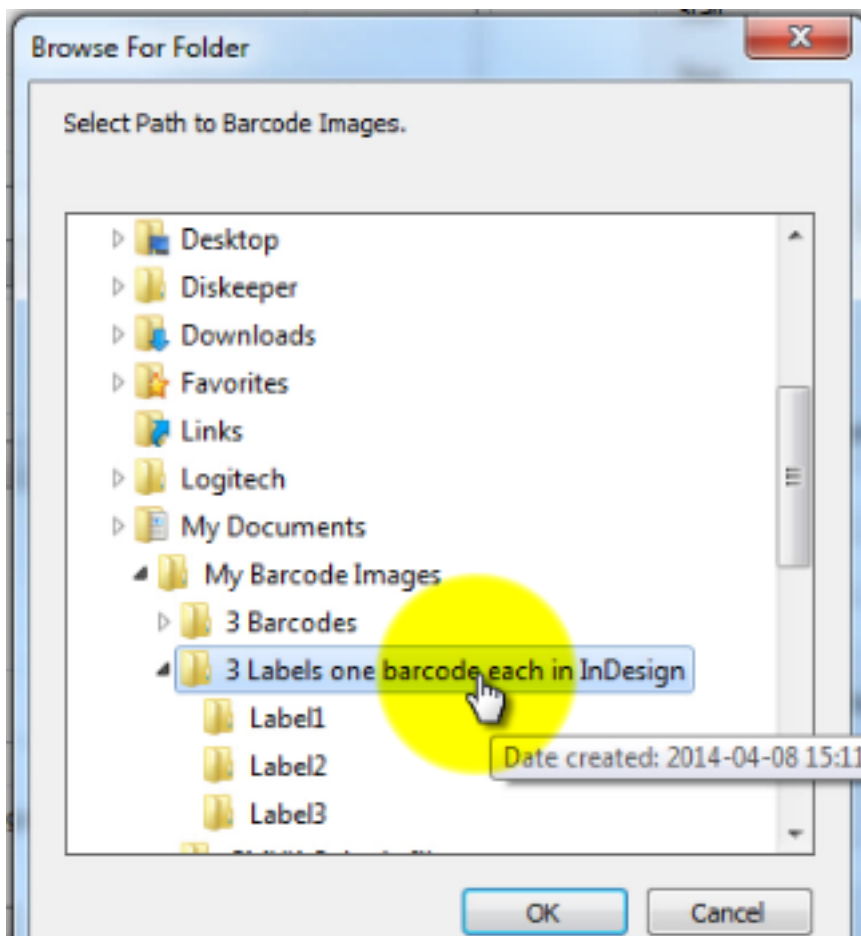


In the area Text in the Panel fill in No. [MSEQ], In Free Text, click on the right mouse button and then click on 'Add Make Sequential [MSEQ]'.

What the above does is adding the file name, in this case _000.eps as text, e.g. _000.eps is going to be No. 000 and make the txtLabel1 to the text file for InDesign when saved . All files and Sub Folders will be added. E.g. txtLabel1, txtLabel2, txtLabel3. Please look at the above image

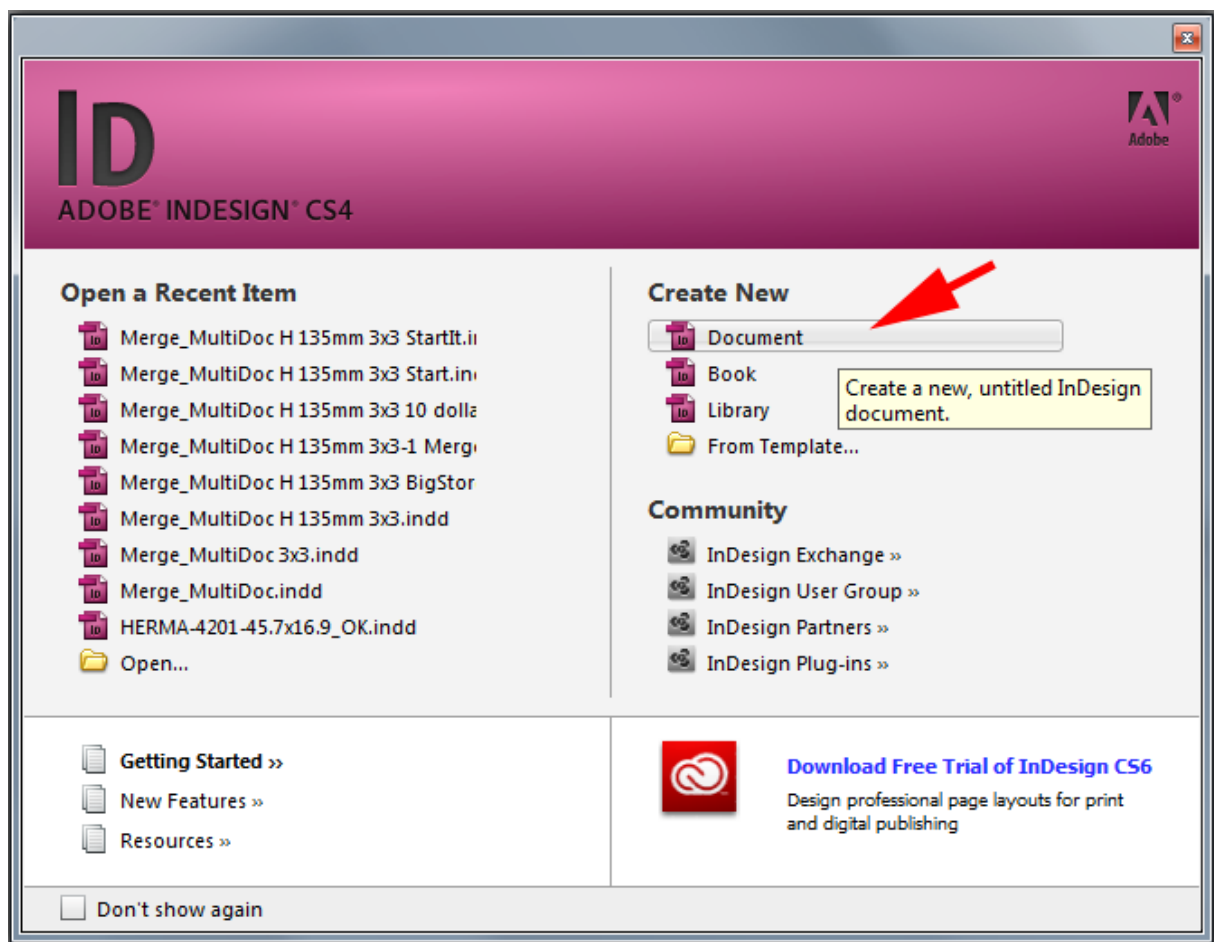


When we have saved the barcode images, then it's time to Export the Comma Delimited text file (*.txt) for Adobe InDesign, click on the Save As. Please look at the above image.



Browser for Folder will show, click on the folder that contains the sub folder, in this case 3 Labels on barcode each in InDesign, then please click on the OK button. Please look at the above image.

Now you will have to fill in a File name for the Comma Delimited text file (*.txt) for Adobe InDesign, I have filled in 3 Labels one barcode each in InDesign





When the above dialog windows shows (Adobe InDesign CS4), select Document, or any format you would like to use for the sequential bar coding or if you have already made a design then just Open it. Please look at the above image.

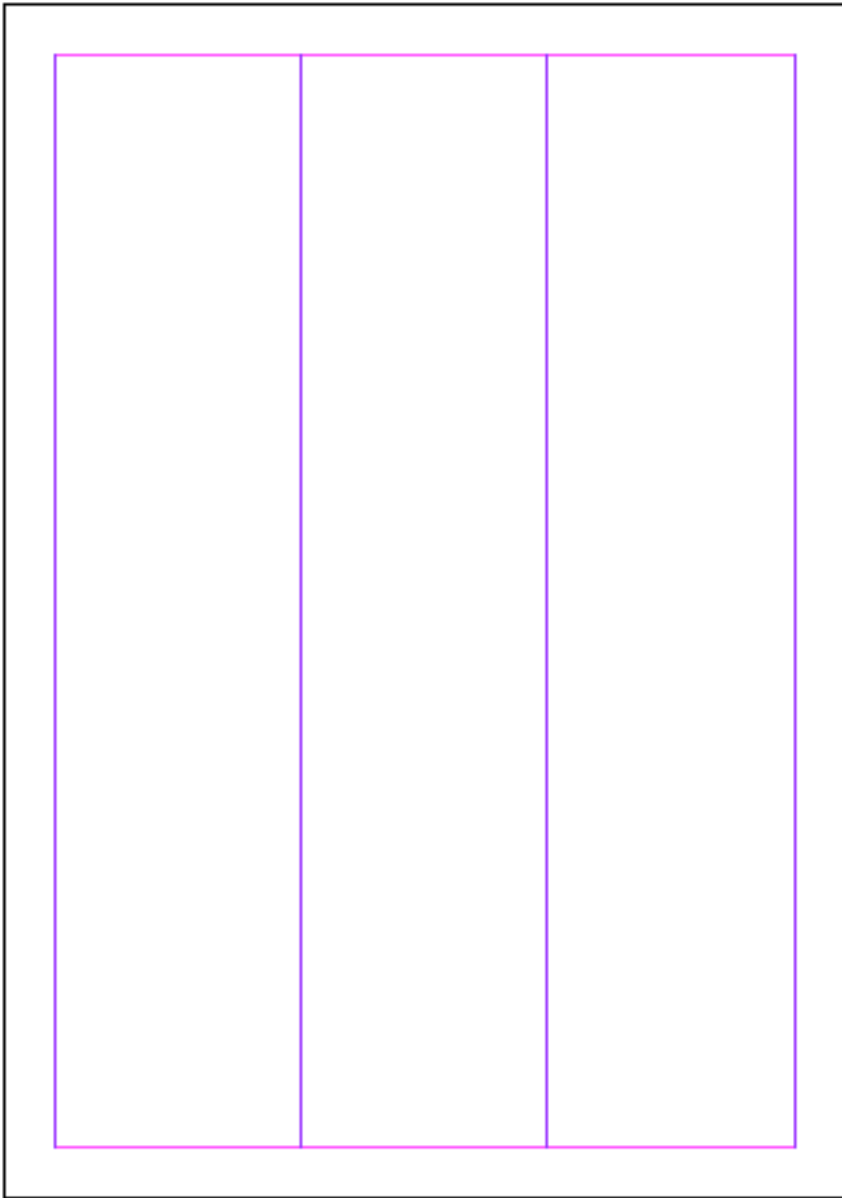

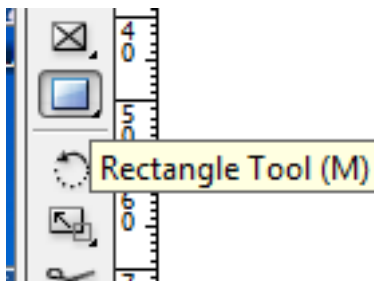

I have selected a A4 document, but any other size would work. In Columns Number: 3 and fill in Gutter: 0 mm, other settings have not been changed (12.7 mm = 0,5 In) Click on the OK button. Please look at the above image.

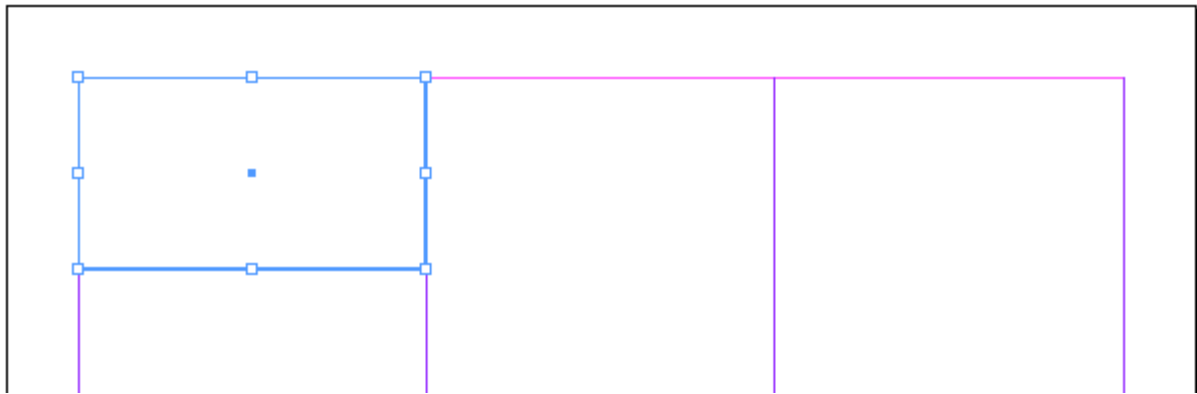


In the above image you can see the page that we have defined, 3 columns, no gutters. Please look at the above image.

Make 3 labels



We are going to use the same size for all the labels, so we only need to make one for each column and the rest will be added automatically by InDesign. Click on the Rectangle Tool as shown in the image above.

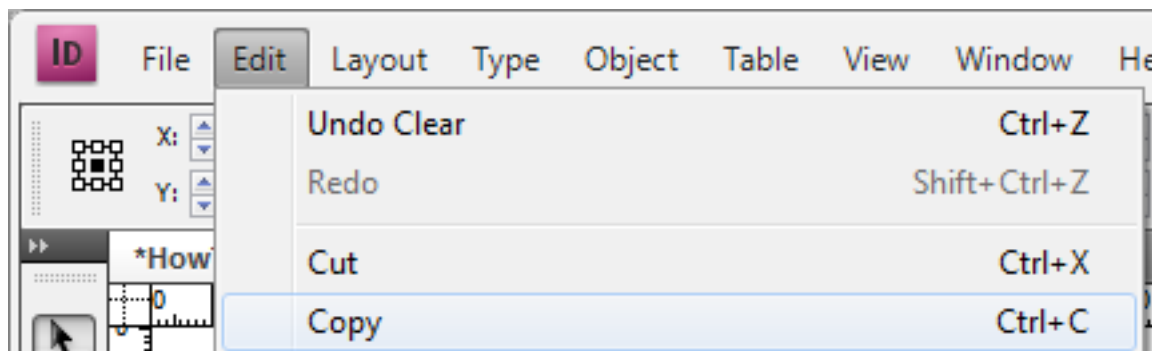


The first label have been added using the Rectangle Tool(M). Please look at the above image.

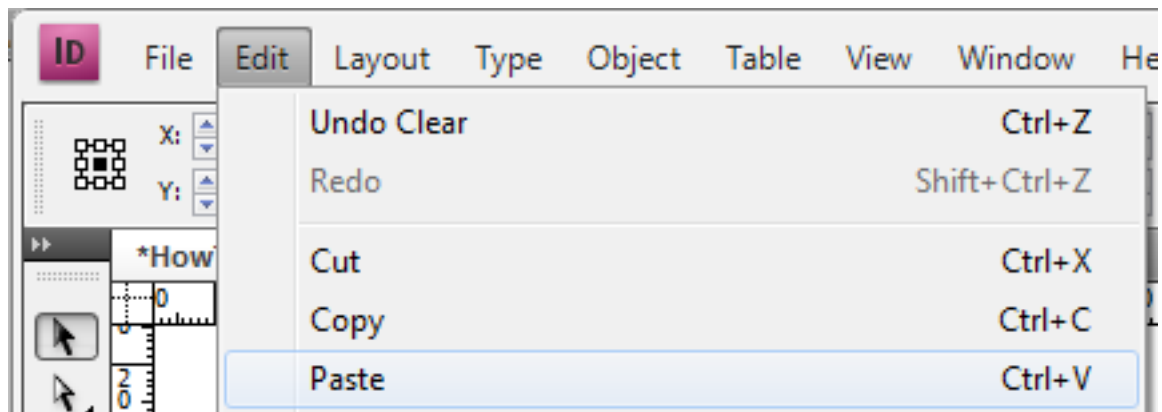

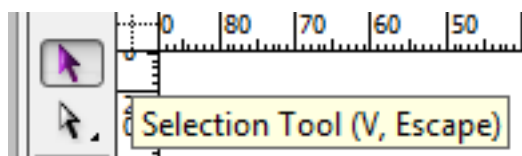

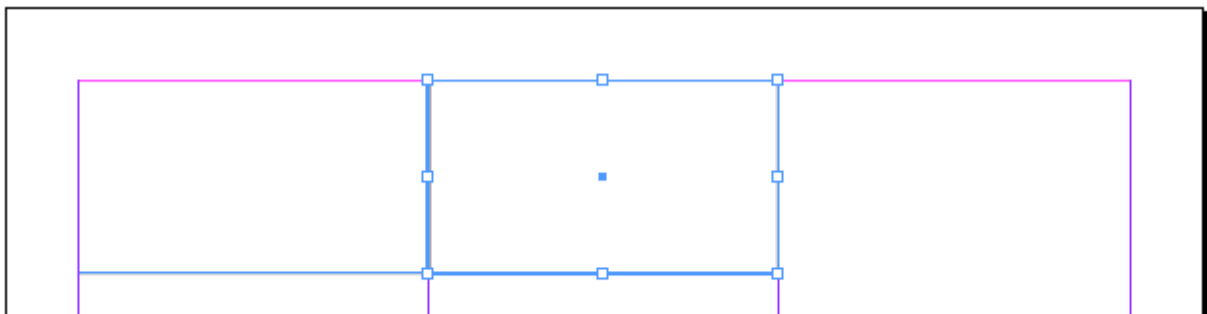
Make sure that the first label (rectangle) have been selected, click on the Edit menu and then click on Copy to copy the Label (Rectangle). Please look at the above image.



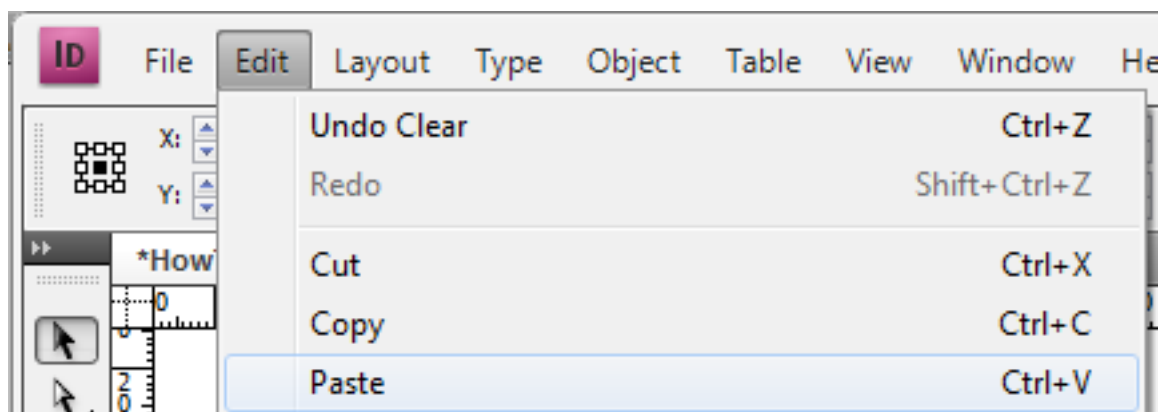
Click on the Edit menu and then click on Paste to get a new label (Rectangle). Please look at the above image.



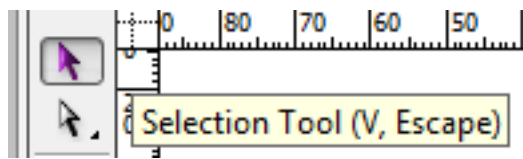
Click on the Selection Tool (V, Escape) to be able to move the label (rectangle) that we pasted in InDesign. Please look at the above image.



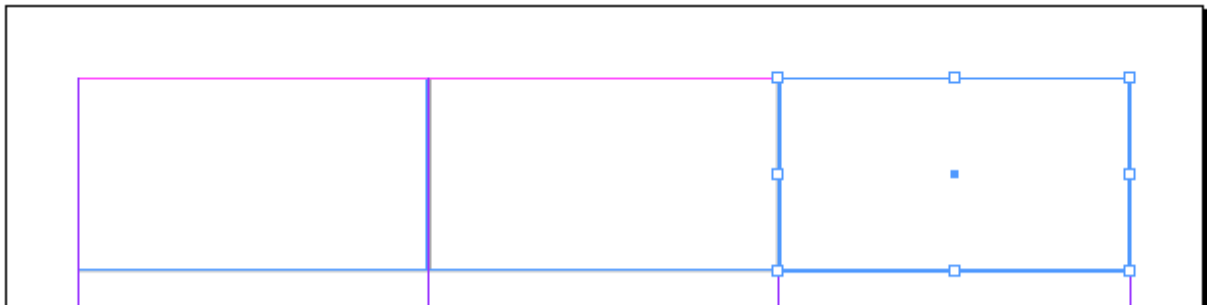
Move the label (rectangle) to right of the first label (rectangle). Please look at the above image.



Click on the Edit menu and then click on Paste to get a new label (Rectangle). Please look at the above image.

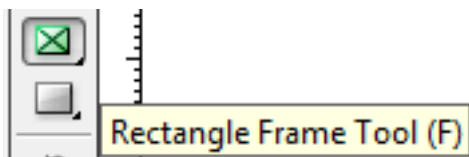


Click on the Selection Tool (V, Escape) to be able to move the label (rectangle) that we pasted in InDesign. Please look at the above image.

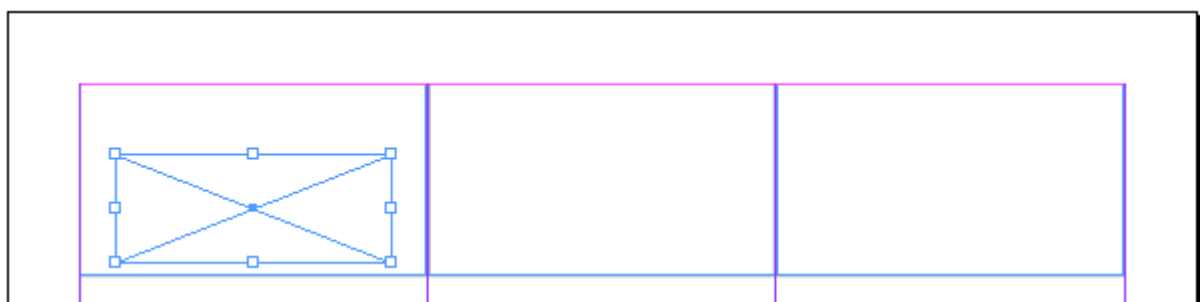


Move the label (rectangle) to right of the second label (rectangle). Now we have three labels (rectangles). Please look at the above image.

Add a rectangle frame



The barcodes and text above the barcode will be placed in a Rectangle Frame, so please select the 'Rectangle Frame Tool (F)' in Adobe InDesign. Please look at the above image.

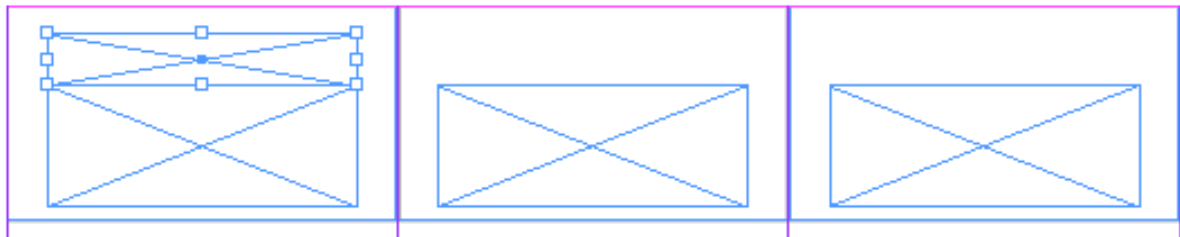


Please add the first Rectangle Frame for the barcode image on the first label (rectangle) as shown in the above image.

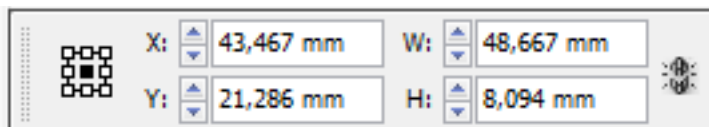

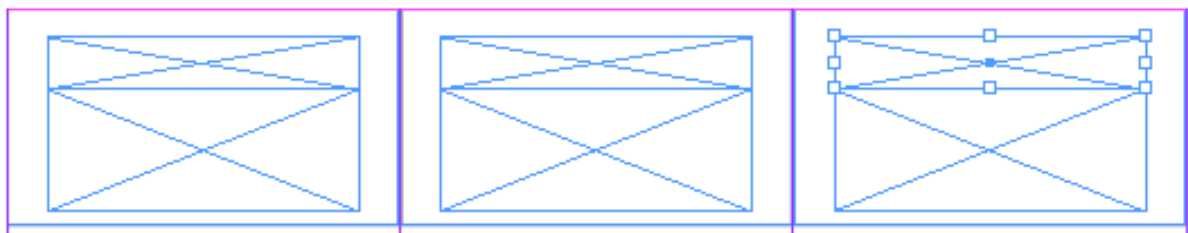


Please add the first Rectangle Frame for the text above the barcode on the first label (rectangle) as shown in the above image



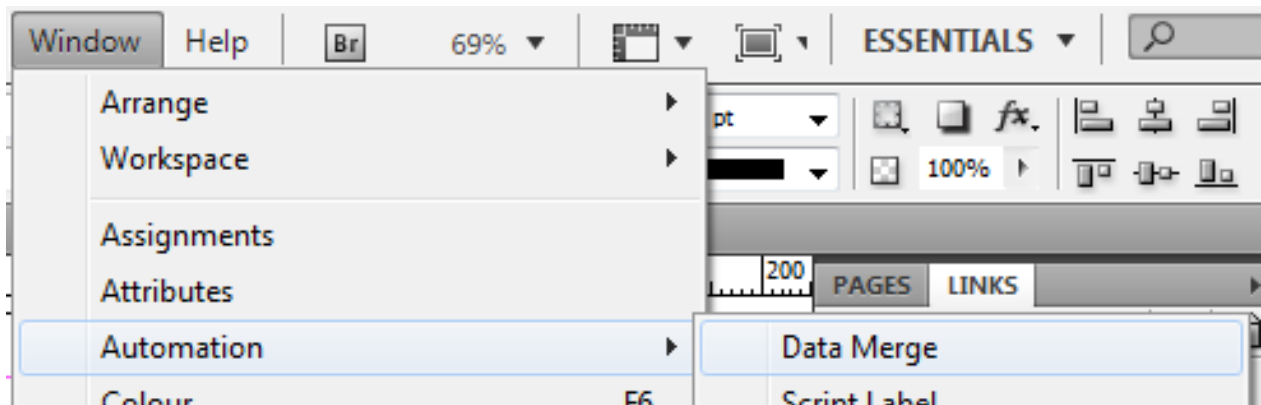

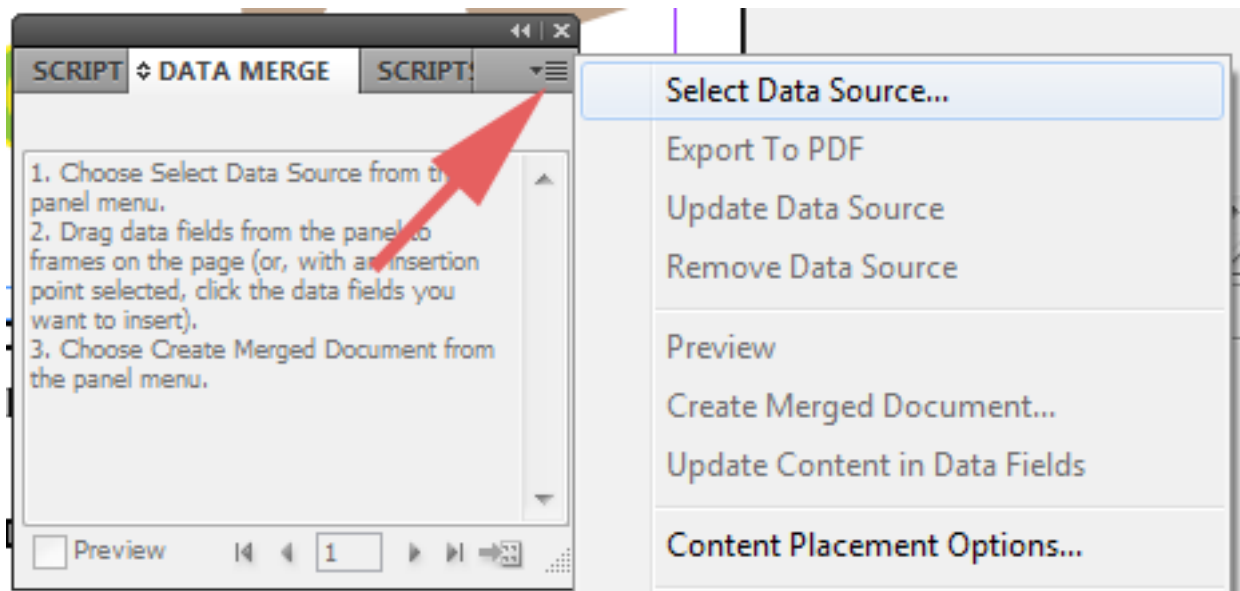


This is what it should look like, three rectangle frames for the barcodes and three rectangle frames for the text above. Please look at the above image.

Automation and Data Merge.



Now it's time to Open the Comma Delimited text file (*.txt) for Adobe InDesign, click on the Windows menu and then move to Automation and click on Data Merge.

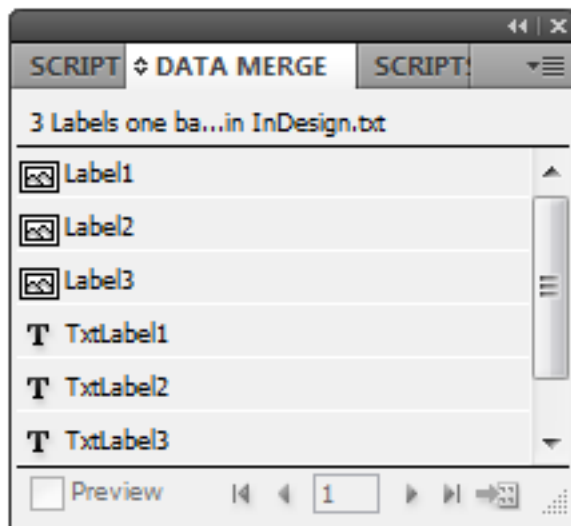


This is also known as the Data Merge palette.

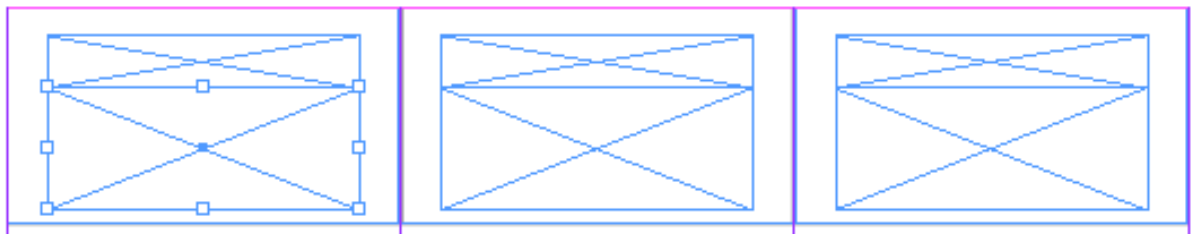
In the Data Merge Palette menu, click on Select Data Source. Please look at the image above.

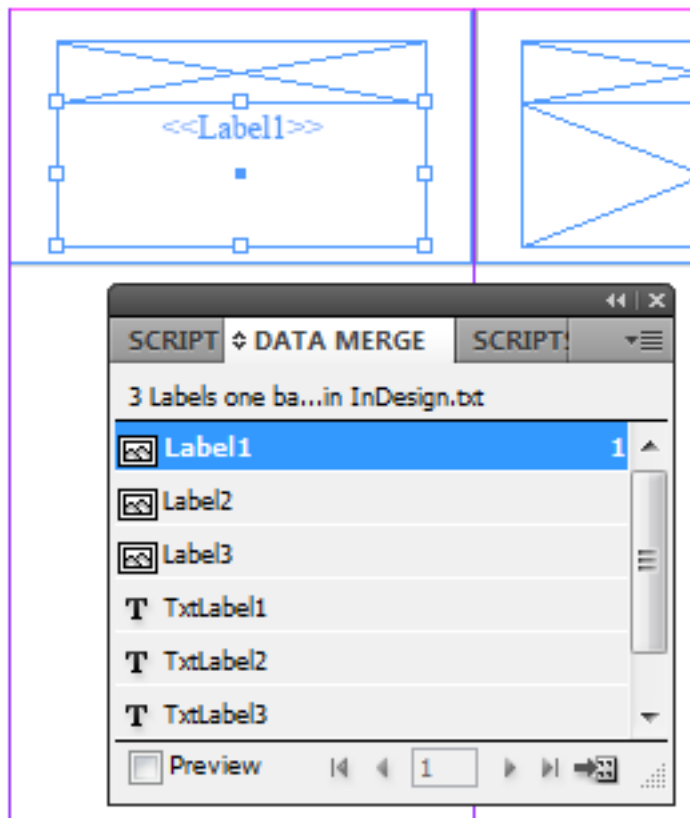
Select and Open the Comma Delimited text file (*.txt) for Adobe InDesign you have saved earlier. Please look at the image above.



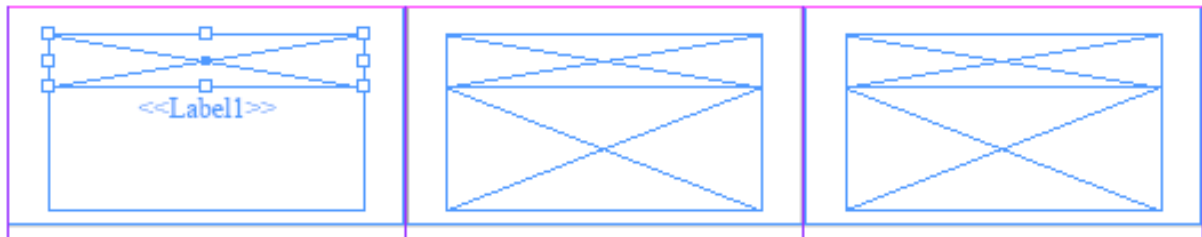
The Data Merge palette shows the possible links to the barcode images and text. Please look at the above image.



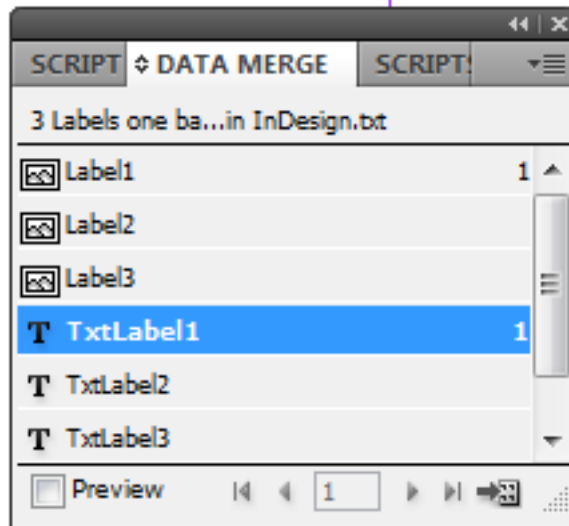
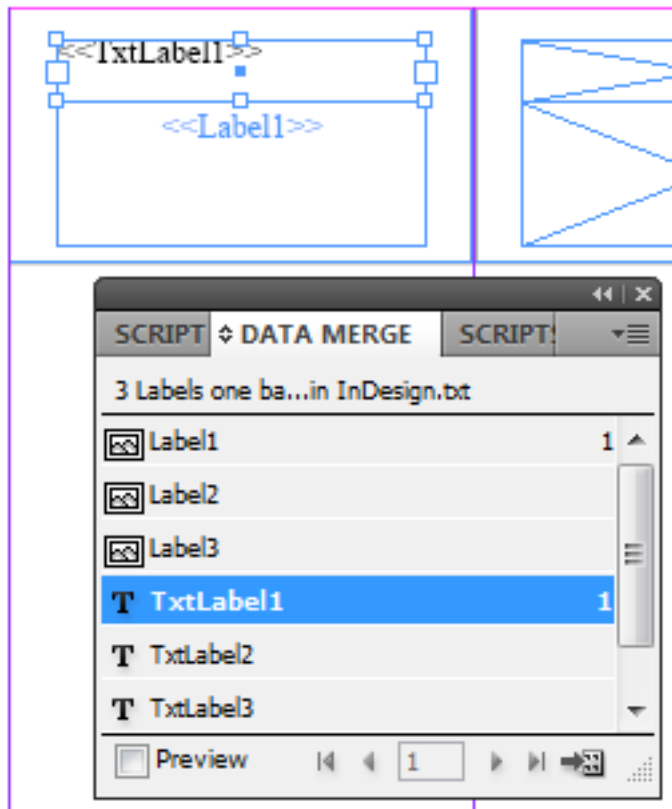
Click on the first rectangle frame as shown in the above image.



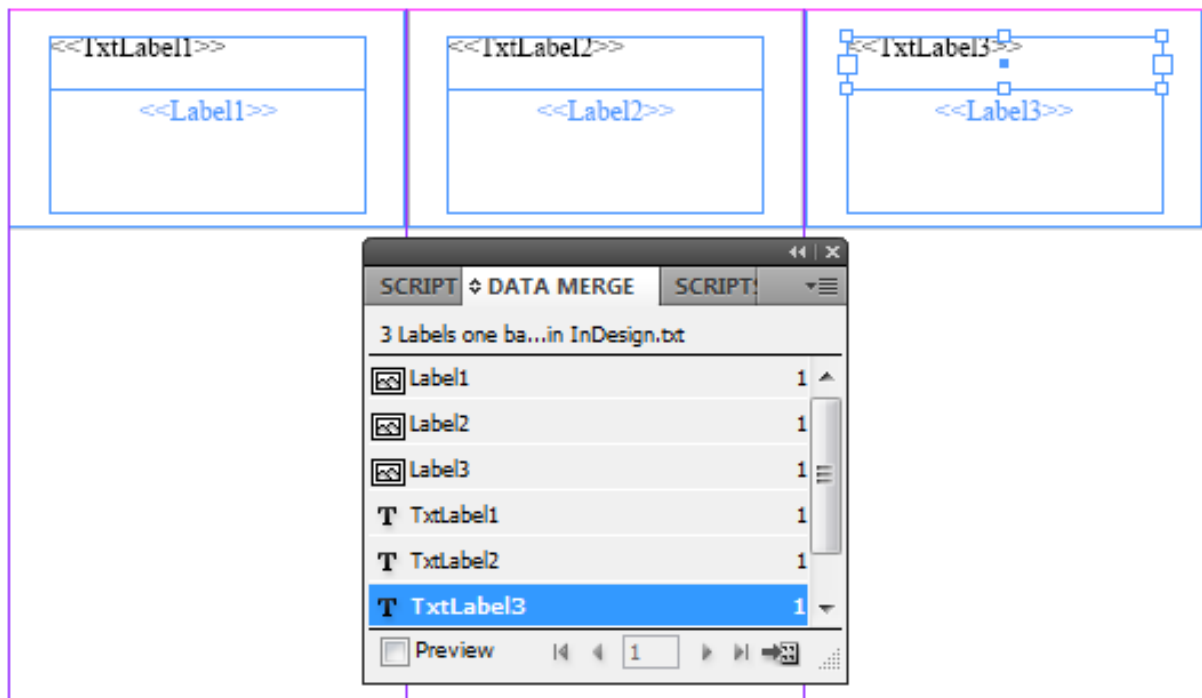
Click on Label1 to link it to the rectangle frame.



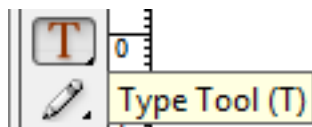
Select the rectangle frame above the <<Label1>>. Please look at the above image.



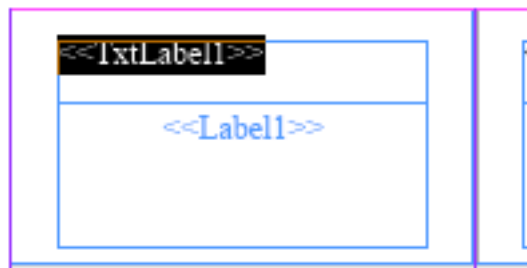
Click on TxtLabel1 to link it to the rectangle frame. Please look at the above image.



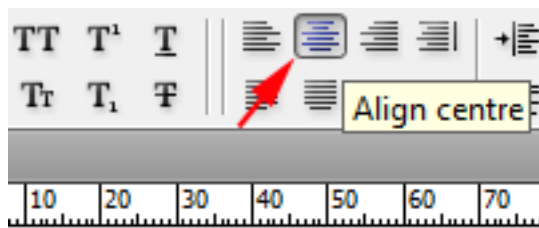
Now that you know how to link Barcode images and text to a rectangle frame, please link the rest of them as shown in the above image.



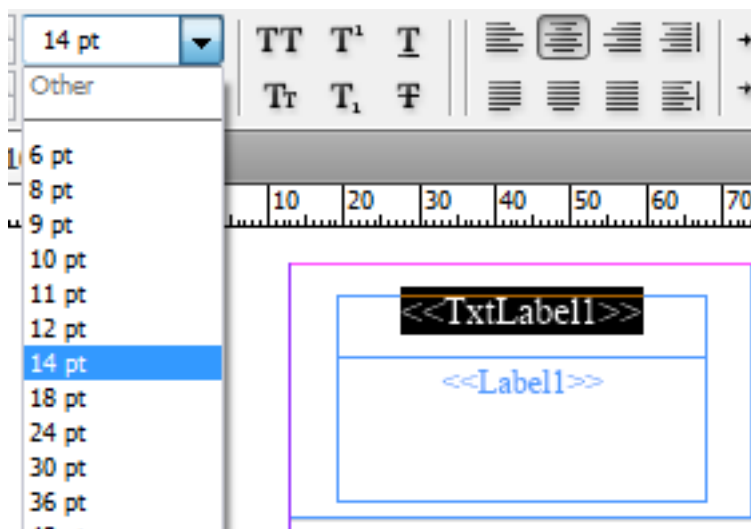
Let's change the Font, Font Size, Font alignment and Font color. So please click on the Type Tool (T) in the Toolbar. Please look at the above image.



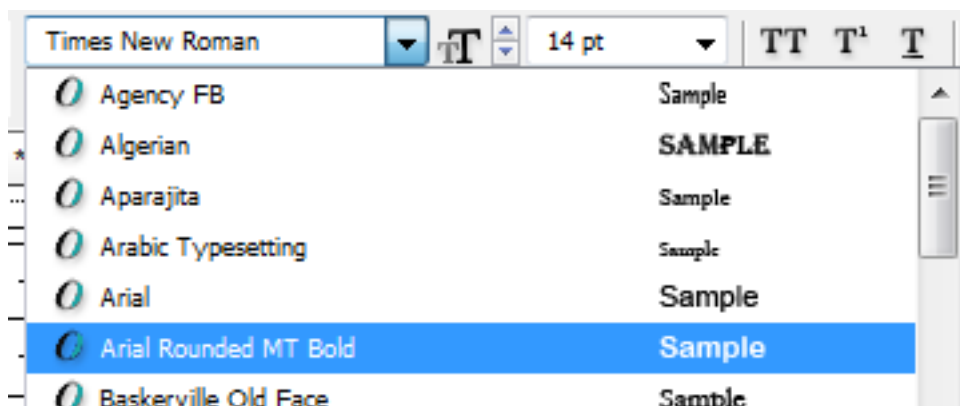
Please select the text as shown in the above image.



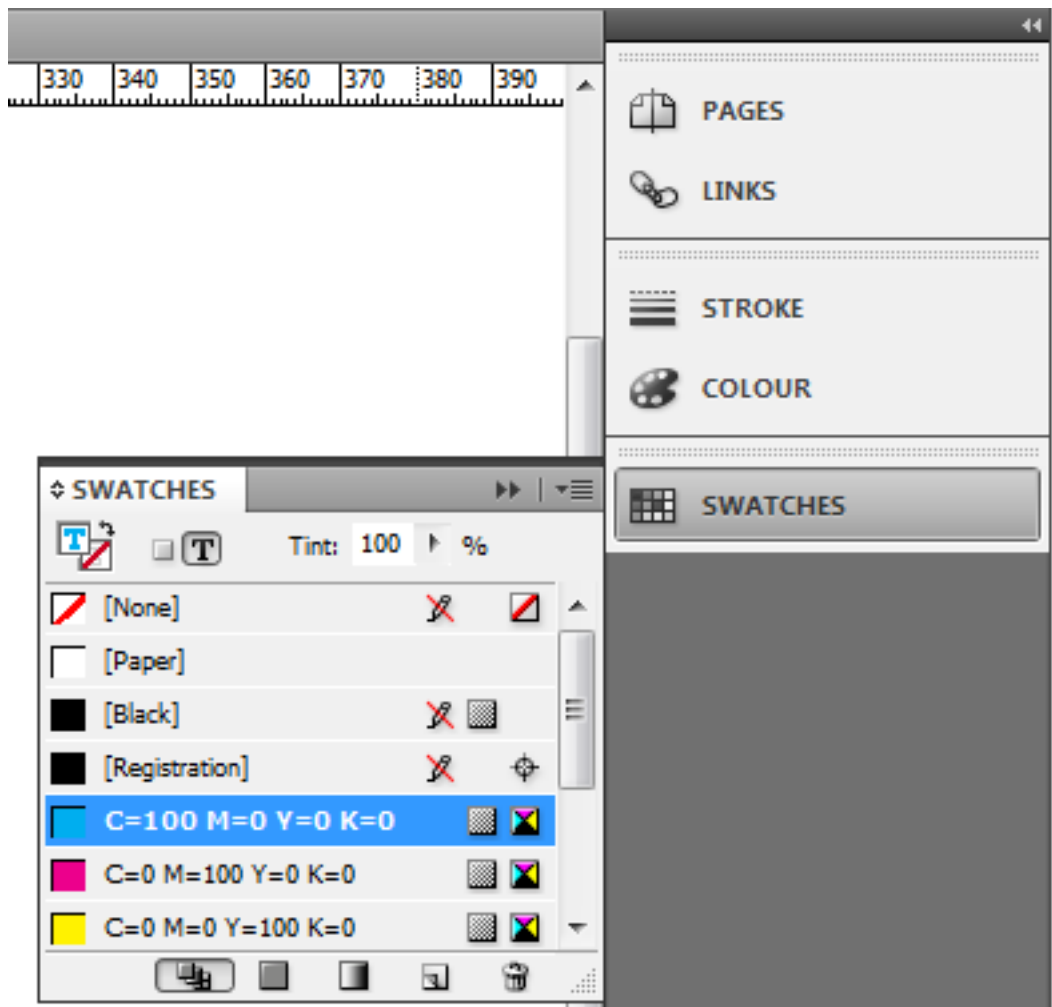
Center the text, click on Align Center as shown in the above image.



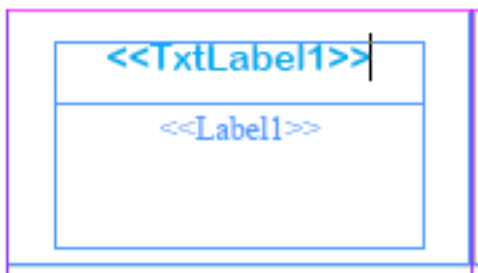
Please change the Font Size to 14 pt as shown in the above image.



I will select the Font, Arial Rounded MT Bold, please look at the above image.



I would also like to change the Font color to Cyan, Please click on Swatches and click on Cyan as shown in the above image.



That's it, we have a Cyan 14 pt Arial Rounded MT Bold, aligned center in the rectangle frame. Please look at the above image.

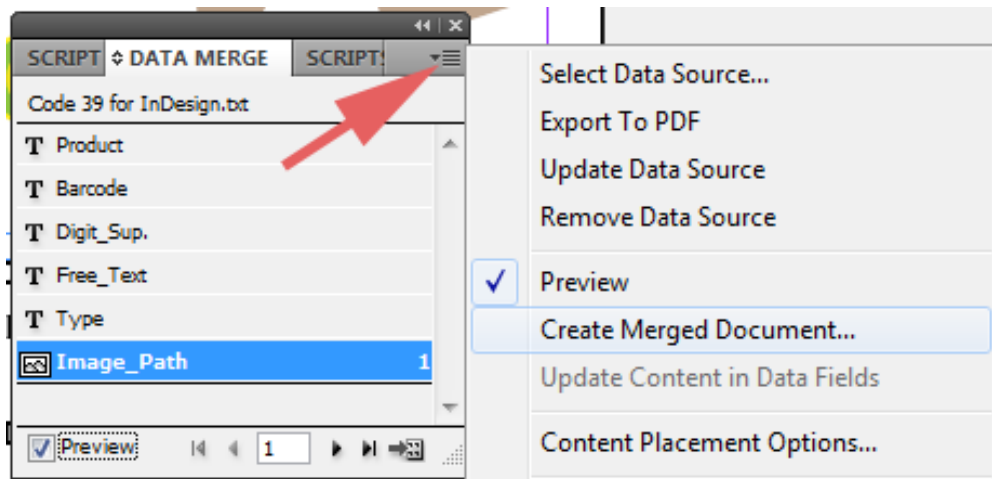


Please make the Font changes to the <<TxtLabel2>> and <<TxtLabel3>> as shown in the image above.



Please check the Preview so that we can see how it looks on the labels (rectangle). The barcode isn't align center, don't worry, we do that later. Please look at the above image.

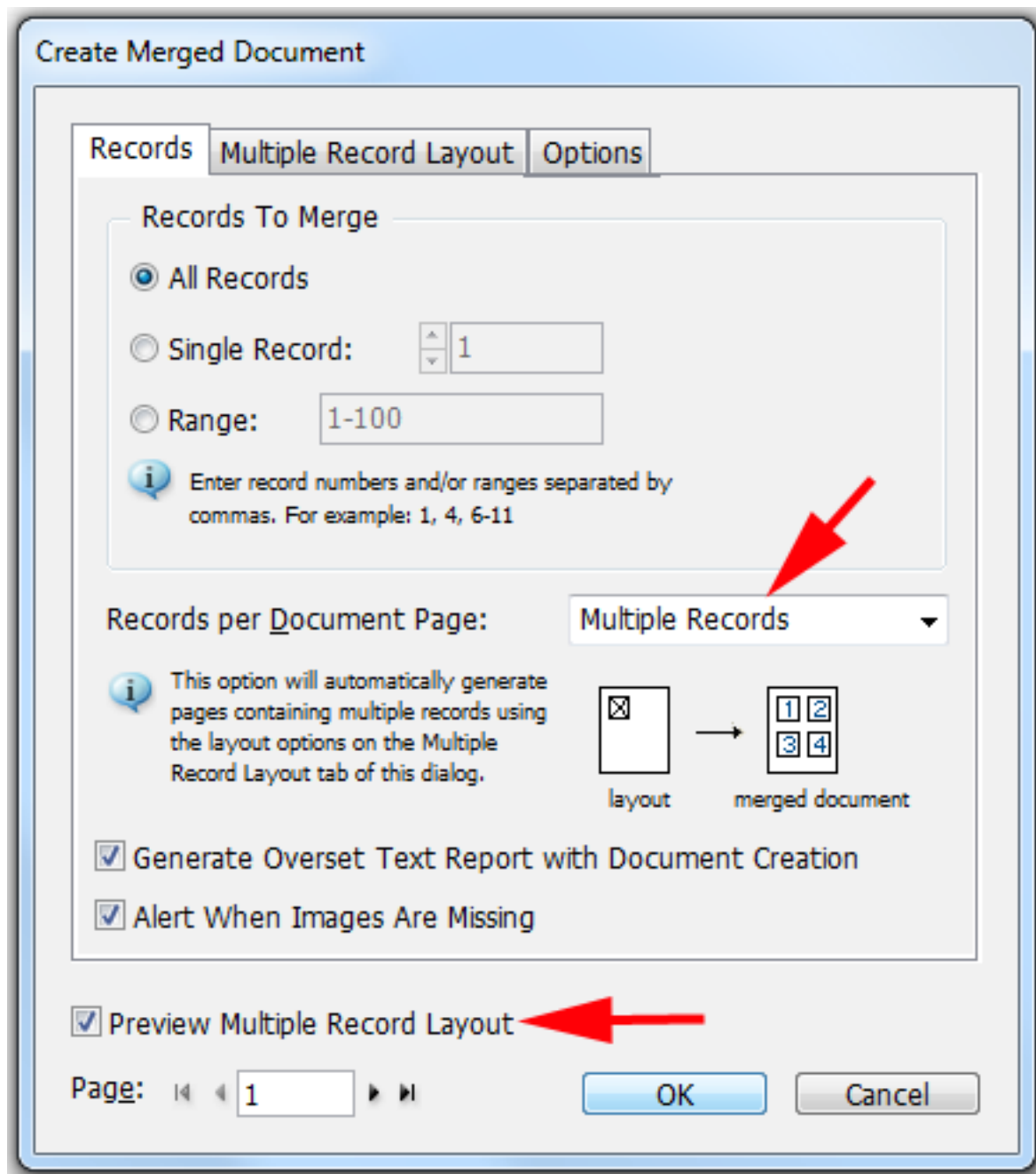
Create Merged Document



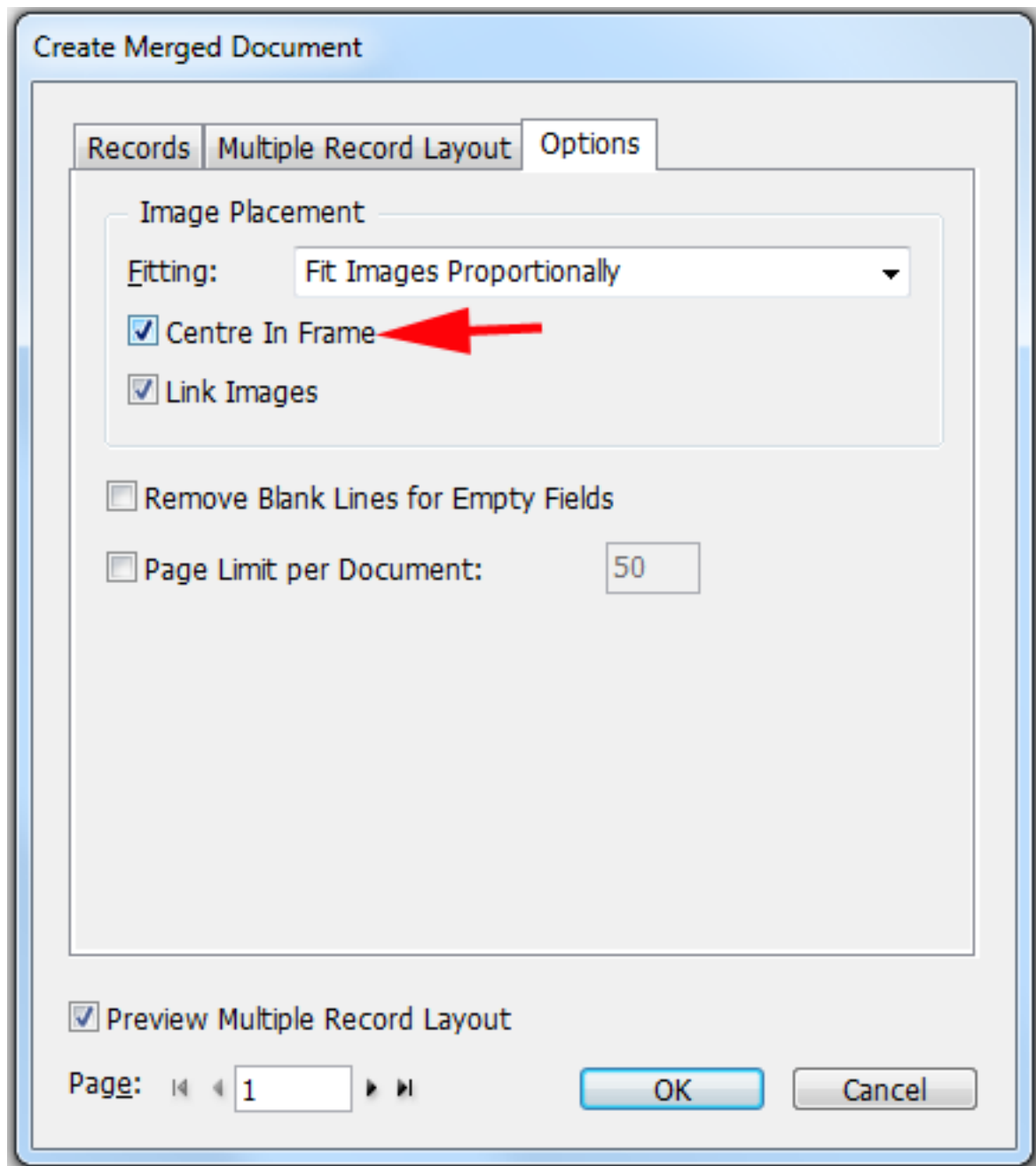
Merge all Barcode Images to a document.

In the Data Merge Palette menu, click on Create Merged Document... Please look at the image above.

Let's use Create Merged Document in Adobe InDesign.



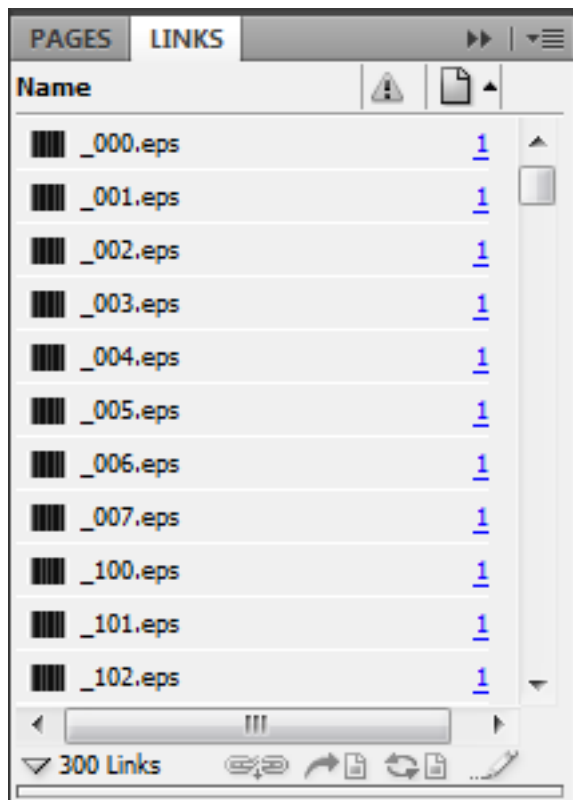
Please change Records per Document Page: to Multiple Records and also please check Preview Multiple Record Layout as shown in the above image.



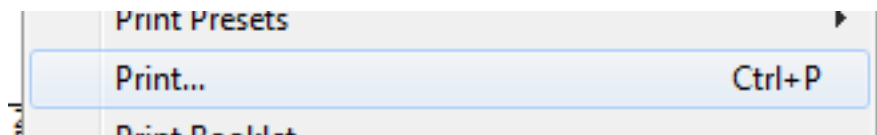
Let's center all the barcode images in the rectangle, click on the Options tab and then please check Center in Frame. Please note that Fitting: is set to Fit Images Proportionally. Please note that is okay for the small barcode we use. But if you use wider barcodes, I would recommend that you use Fit Frames to Images. Please click on the OK button. Please look at the above image.
