

# Mailit 6 Revision History

This document contains details regarding improvements of the Mailit 6 FileMaker plug-in.

## Mailit version 6.0.5.37 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Fixed: The "Emai\_PopGetAttachmentIcon" could return error "-042". This has been fixed.
- Fixed: The "Emai\_HTMLToFmText" function would cut the text on certain non-ASCII characters. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: Plug-in used to save the last known log file location. This could cause a load failure if the last location path would not be accessible. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: The "Emai\_ImapDeleteMessage" function call would crash if requested UID would not exist. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: The "Emai\_ImapMoveMessage" function call would freeze if requested UID would not exist. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: Certain custom MIME structures could result into missing message body. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: Plug-in crash on Mac OS 10.10 with FileMaker 11 has been addressed.
- Fixed: Plug-in crash on Mac OS 10.9 with FileMaker 14 has been addressed.
- Improved: The naming convention of the file exported by "Emai\_ExportFile" function has been changed to facilitate the file recognition.

## Mailit version 6.0.4.35 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Improved: The **FileMaker 15** compatibility.

## Mailit version 6.0.3.32 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Fixed: The "Emai\_ExportHtml" would ignore the optional charset parameter. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: The plug-in could fail to display dialog windows on Windows version of FileMaker 14. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: The HTML code extracted from the message could miss the leading tag. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: The default charset set by the "Emai\_SetDefaultCharset" function could have been ignored for incoming messages. This has been addressed.

### Mailit version 6.0.2.31 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Fixed: When running FileMaker using OpenDirectory account the plug-in could crash. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: The file name of incoming attachment with non-ASCII characters in file name could be distorted. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: "Emai\_ShowFolderDialog" could return an empty result on Windows 7. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: "Emai\_ImapGetMessageField" call after "Emai\_ImapGetMessageInfo" could cause a crash. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: "Emai\_OpenFile" would fail on first call if the file name contains non-ASCII characters. This has been addressed.
- Improved: The **FileMaker 14** compatibility.
- Improved: The log file location generated on Server side has been changed to the same location where FileMaker Server log files are stored.

### Mailit version 6.0.1.26 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Fixed: "Emai\_GetFileSize" would always return "0". This has been fixed.
- Fixed: "{defaultFolderPath}" parameter of the "Emai\_ShowFileDialog" function was ignored. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: HTML conversion to plain text using certain encodings could result into incorrect characters. This has been fixed.
- Fixed: "Emai\_PopGetMessagePriority" would return empty string in case if there is no priority specification available in message header. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: In case if user ID on Windows 7 would include non-ASCII characters the plug-in would load to load preferences on plug-in start-up.
- Fixed: "Emai\_ConvertPath" has been updated according to specifics of Mac OS X 10.9
- Fixed: "Emai\_ShowFileDialog" could crash on Mac OS X 10.8.5. This has been addressed.
- Fixed: "Emai\_ConvertPath" could fail on Mac OS X 10.9/10.10.
- Fixed: "Emai\_ExportFile" could fail on sequential file export. This has been addressed.
- Improved: HTML to plain text conversion has been improved.
- Improved: Message object processing has been improved.

### Mailit version 6.0.0.14 for Windows and Mac OS X

- Initial release
