2 First steps

2.1 Have you bought your webEdition license in our online shop?

After finishing the transaction you saw a confirmation window with the request to print out this confirmation. This print-out provides you with your serial number and your log-in for the customer area of our homepage www.webedition.biz.

You can install webEdition on your server only with this serial number. There are no further information or data necessary for installation, you can start immediately after receiving your serial number. You will find the newest version of webEdition for download at <http://www.webedition.de/english/downloads/we.html>. In case you install webEdition without a valid serial number, the demo version will be installed. (No saving of templates allowed).

2.2 Have you bought your webEdition licence via Fax?

Your data will be entered in our customer management system by our staff, you will receive two e-mails sent to the address you filled in the fax form. The first mail contains your serial number, the second your log-in for the customer area of our homepage www.webedition.biz.

You can install webEdition on your server only with this serial number. There are no further information or data necessary for installation, you can start immediately after receiving your serial number. You will find the newest version of webEdition for download at <http://www.webedition.de/english/downloads/we.html>. In case you install webEdition without a valid serial number, the demo version will be installed. (No saving of templates allowed).

2.3 Where are the modules?

webEdition are delivered in one single archive file (.zip for Windows or .sit for Mac OS) which contains all modules. During the installation process you have to enter your serial number. In our customer management system is fixed what modules you have bought and your serial number is the key to this record (this is the reason why you have to be online during the installation process). There's no need to download any modules separately!

2.4 How to upgrade a module?

In case you have bought a new module and would like to upgrade your version of webEdition, you just have to repeat the installation process. During the installation process you choose "module installation" and select the bought module (See Chapter 3.3 in the manual). Your record in our customer management system have been updated after purchasing your module and allows the installation.

2.5 You have lost your serial number?

Please enter the customer area of our homepage with the log in data provided. There you will find your serial number and an exact record of your system.

3 Installation requirements

In order to install webEdition on a web-server, you must meet the following requirements:

- PC (min. Windows 95) or Mac (OS 9.x or OS X) for installation with the Installer Programme. Manual installation is possible with all systems, including Linux.¹
- Access to an FTP server, PHP4, and an MySQL database (either local, or from a service provider)
- Installation CD-ROM or download version of webEdition
- Web-server or provider with FTP access (with local installation the domain name is "localhost"), PHP4² and MySQL database
- Your own domain (www.domainname.com) or IP-address. A local installation via "localhost" is also possible. Note: webEdition cannot be installed into a subdirectory!
- The web-server (Apache or IIS) needs to have write-access permissions to the root directory.³
- You require 2-5 MB harddisc space; the same amount of harddisc space is required for the MySQL database.
- Internet access during registration and installation.⁴

Attention Users of Windows MySQL Servers:

If the MySQL server prohibits the "FLUSH TABLES" function, and PHP cannot run as a CGI-Version, an error occurs while changing classes (in the Database/Object Module), and while importing a backup file with user data (an import without user data functions properly). If a MySQL server is run on UNIX, there is no problem, even if the web server is running on Windows. We are aware of this problem, and we shall find a solution as soon as possible.

¹ If you work with a Linux PC, or if the Installer Programme fails to function on your system, you can also install webEdition using your browser. Download the Windows version of the Installer Programme and unzip the files. Go to the "files" directory, and copy the "weinstall" directory in binary mode to the root-directory of your web server. This is the directory which contains your files and your index.html file. Enter the following setup script into your browser: <http://www.yourdomain.com/weinstall/setup.php> If your webserver does not recognize .php as a PHP4 setting, you can complete the process using setup.php4 or setup.phtml. Thereafter, follow the on-screen instructions.

² At present we only guarantee 100% functionality starting from PHP 4.0.6. The configuration variable "register_globals" has to be set to "On". This was the standard setting in all versions prior to PHP 4.2. If you use PHP 4.2 you have to set this in the php.ini file (register_globals = On;). Likewise the configuration variable "allow_url_fopen" has to be set to "On" as well! To our knowledge most of the ISPs offer these as standard settings. Furthermore the ISP has to allow PHP-Scripts as executables in any directory; not just within a specific directory (e. g. cgi-bin).

³ The Root directory is the directory which holds the index.html (and/or default.htm). In order to be able to install and use webEdition the Webserver has to have the write permission into the Root directory. Many ISPs separate the FTP user and the Webserver in separate accounts (2 different users). Usually the Root directory belongs to the FTP account. In that case the Webserver may not be able to write into the Root directory, unless it has the necessary permissions (chmod 777). If so it is important to disable the "safe_mode" of PHP during the installation of webEdition. If you do not know how to change these settings please contact your ISP or system administrator.

⁴ If you are not able to install webEdition because your system is protected by a firewall or in a private network, please contact us. We have a special webEdition installer ("Firewallinstaller") available.

4 Important information about installation and updates

4.1 Important information about installation and updates to Version 2.2

If you have installed the Customer Management Module, you must perform a rebuild with “Save templates in advance” after the update. Select “Rebuild...” from the webEdition “Edit” menu and perform a rebuild. Activate the “Save templates in advance”.

4.1.1 New installation of webEdition Version 2.2

Start the installer application on your computer and follow the instructions in the the following document: [installation_information.pdf](#).

4.1.2 Upgrading from Version 2.0.2 and higher to webEdition Version 2.2

If you are upgrading to webEdition Version 2.2.0.7 from Version 2.0.2, you can upgrade your software from within webEdition. Open webEdition, and select “Update” from the “Edit” menu. For further information see following document: [installation_information.pdf](#).

4.1.3 Upgrading from webEdition 2.0.1 or older to webEdition Version 2.2

Updates to Version 2.2 are only possible if you first perform an update to Version 2.0.2. For all updates from older versions to Version 2.0.2, start the installer V. 2.0.2 on your computer. Enter Update/moduleinstallation. For further information about updates from older versions to Version 2.0.2, see the document titled [old_installation.pdf](#).

Attention: Updates from Version 1.5.2 to 2.2

Updates from 1.5.2 to 2.0.2 often encounter a problem with patches for the databank. We recommend the following procedure.

1. Export a Backup in webEdition and/or “dump” the databank (the structure and data of all tables that begin with “tbl”) in phpMyAdmin with the setting “With DROP TABLE) and “with full INSERTs”
2. Before proceeding, you must verify that there are no errors in both the backup file and the phpMyAdmin-Dump. You can do this by opening your files with any text-editor application. If you see that your SQL commands are in order, then the file was backed up properly. If, however, you see MySQL and PHP errors, repeat step 1. If errors persist, contact your service provider and report to them what happens when you do a mysql-Dump from your databank.
3. Perform a new installation with version 2.1.0.4. Thereafter complete the registration and install the modules.
4. Import the backup/phpMyAdmin-Dump using the Backup-Imports.
5. Perform a rebuild for all templates. If you have static documents which are associated with other documents by the <we:include> tag, it is recommended that you perform another rebuild on the “static pages”.

Attention: For every update, create a backup of the contents of your databank. Go to "Edit" menu → "Backup" → "Export"

Important notice for users of the tag <we:form type="formmail">

To avoid spamming, in version 2.0.2 we introduced a new funktion in the edit menu. It is called formmail recipients. You have to define to what e-mail addresses the formmail should be sent. With a click on the menu option "Formmail recipients", a window will open. There you can enter the addresses to which formails could be sent. If no addresses are specified, the formmail function is blocked. In case you have used the formmail function in prior versions of webEdition, you have to enter the addresses which are defined in the template (<we:form type="formmail"> under "recipients") in the formmail recipients function.
